POINT SYSTEM:

- 30 Points: Donation to the Scholarship Fund prior to December 31 dues payment deadline.
- 10 Points: State newsletter sent to the National Auxiliary Awards Chair.
- 20 Points: State newsletter sent to the National Auxiliary President.
- 15 Points: Semi-Annual State President's report sent to the National Auxiliary President by due date.
- 10 Points: New state officers' list sent to the National Auxiliary Awards Chair. Deadline: June 1 of current year.
- 20 Points: New state officer's list sent to the National Auxiliary President. Deadline: June 1 of current year.
- 10 Points: State conference dates sent to the National Auxiliary Awards Chair two months prior.
- 20 Points: State conference dates sent to the National Auxiliary President two months prior.
- 15 Points: Any state auxiliary and/or state association recognition, award or certificate presented to any state auxiliary member and/or state auxiliary organization. (The National Auxiliary President must receive documentation of recognition, award or certificate no later than June 1 of current year.
- 50 BONUS POINTS: Each state auxiliary that pays membership dues and sends membership roster to the National Treasurer postmarked before the December 31 dues payment deadline.

EANGUS AUXILIARY DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD

- 1. <u>Purpose</u>: To provide significant recognition to any individual who shall distinguish himself/herself with outstanding service at a state and/or national level.
- 2. Eligibility: Any member of the EANGUS Auxiliary not currently serving on the Executive Board.
- 3. <u>Criteria</u>: The following criteria is established to serve as guidelines in the selection of recipients for this award.
 - <u>A.</u> An individual must have distinguished himself/herself with exceptionally outstanding service at a state and/or national level.

4. **NOMINATION REQUIREMENT:**

- <u>A</u>. Letter(s) of recommendations by state auxiliary member.
- B. Endorsement of state auxiliary president.
- C. Nomination packet deadline is June 1 of current year.
- D. Email packet directly to the National Auxiliary President.
- E. The National Auxiliary President will email recommendations to the Executive Council for a vote.

EANGUS AUXILIARY OUTSTANDING AREA DIRECTORS' AWARD

- 1. <u>Eligible Persons</u>: Area Directors
- 2. <u>Criteria</u>: Contribution, achievements, service to the EANGUS Auxiliary and the respective auxiliaries within the states they represent.
- 3. Selection Method.

EANGUS AUXILIARY AWARDS CRITERIA

EANGUS AUXILIARY OUTSTANDING AREA DIRECTORS' AWARD (Continued)

POINT SYSTEM:

- 50 Points: Charter/bringing back a dormant state.
- 20 Points: Area Director's newsletters sent to the National Auxiliary Awards Chair.
- 25 Points: Area Director's newsletters sent to the National Auxiliary President.
- 30 Points: Semi-Annual Reports submitted to the National Auxiliary President by due date.
- 25 Points: For each state conference attended (documentation required to include copy of registration and/or receipt of hotel accommodations).
- 25 Points: For attendance to EANGUS/EANGUS Auxiliary Area Caucuses/Mid-Winter Conferences

(documentation required to include copy of registration and/or receipt of hotel accommodations).

25 Points: For attendance to EANGUS/EANGUS Auxiliary-related meetings (i.e. Legislative Workshop,

Membership/Leadership Workshop). Documentation required to include copy of registration and/or receipt of hotel accommodations).

EANGUS AUXILIARY MERITORIOUS SERVICE AWARD

- Purpose: To recognize an individual's outstanding contributions, achievements, and service to the EANGUS Auxiliary.
- 2. <u>Eligibility</u>: Any member of the Enlisted Association of the National Guard of the United States (EANGUS).
- 3. <u>Criteria</u>: The following criteria are established to serve as guidelines in the selection of recipients for this award.
 - A. Outstanding performance by the individual must have been such as to clearly identify the nominee as having played a key role in the accomplishments for which this award is to be given.
 - <u>B.</u> Although a single accomplishment may be considered for this award, priority consideration should be given to those individuals who have contributed outstanding service on a sustained basis.
 - C. Personal dedication and self-sacrifice also will be regarded as factors deserving consideration.

4. **NOMINATION REQUIREMENT**

- <u>A.</u> Letter(s) of recommendation by State Auxiliary member(s).
- B. Endorsement by State Auxiliary President.
- <u>C.</u> AND/OR letter(s) of recommendation by National Auxiliary officer and/or Area Directors.
- D. Endorsement by National Auxiliary President.
- E. Nomination packet deadline is June 1 of current year.
- <u>F.</u> Email packet directly to the National Auxiliary President.
- <u>G.</u> The National Auxiliary President will email recommendations to the Executive Council for a vote.

EANGUS AUXILIARY SPOUSE OF THE YEAR AWARD

- 1. <u>Purpose:</u> To provide recognition to the spouse of a member of the EANGUS Auxiliary.
- 2. <u>Eligibility</u>: Any spouse of a member of the EANGUS Auxiliary.
- 3. <u>Criteria:</u> This will serve as a guideline in selection of recipient.
 - A. Exceptional support of their spouse in their service to the EANGUS.
 - <u>B</u>. Additional consideration will be given to involvement in civic affairs, community involvement, and professional activities.

3. Nomination Requirement:

- <u>A.</u> Letter of recommendation from any EANGUS Auxiliary member with supporting justification to include clear, detailed statements and documentation if appropriate.
- B. Packet deadline is June 1 of current year.
- <u>C.</u> Email packet directly to the National Auxiliary President.
- D. The National Auxiliary President will email recommendations to the Executive Council for a vote.

WHO CAN JOIN?

Annual Member: A Spouse of active, retired, or former Guard member, who is a member of EANGUS and a member of a state Auxiliary chartered to the National AUXILIARY.

Life Member: A current annual member may apply for life membership by paying a onetime dues payment that is determined by current state and national dues that apply up to age 60. The applicant's spouse must be a Life member of their state association and EANGUS.

National Associate Member: An Individual who supports the objectives of the AUXILIARY but does not otherwise qualify for Annual or Lifetime membership.

National Life Associate Member: An Individual who supports the objectives of the AUXILIARY but does not otherwise qualify for

Annual or Lifetime membership by paying a one-time payment of \$100.

HISTORY

The AUXILIARY, a non-profit organization was founded in 1974 by a group of spouses who recognized the need to form a national auxiliary to EANGUS. The AUXILIARY is a grassroots organization that began with 11-chartered state auxiliaries. Through growth and prosperity, it now has 50-chartered state auxiliaries.



PURPOSE OF THE AUXILIARY

THE PURPOSE OF THE AUXILIARY IS TO SUPPORT THE ENLISTED ASSOCIATION OF THE NATIONAL GUARD OF THE UNITED STATES (EANGUS), in attaining goals and objectives, and to provide support and fellowship among National Guard families. Along with supporting the ENLISTED ASSOCIATION'S legislative efforts, the AUXILIARY is also concerned with family issues and provides scholarships for spouses and dependents.
